Additional Exhibitor Information

BRING YOUR OWN SHADE AND WATER.

Stakes will be split if the entry is 24 or more hounds at the time of Roll Call. Dogs not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fee not refunded. Hounds will be run twice, in braces or trios (except single dog entries) unless dismissed, excused or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and their entry fee refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call. All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing their hounds. A **STANDING START** will be used on Tallyho. Muzzles and catch collars may be used at the handlers' discretion. Leg wrappings must be a neutral color to comply with CKC rules. There will be a \$5.00 fine for dogs found loose on the coursing field after roll call and before the end of the trial. Coursing entries received after the closing date will be charged the "late/day of trial" fee.



HOUND CERTIFICATION FORM

Effective, July 1, 1998: Chapter 3, Section 3.1.2 (A). A hound must be tested with another dog, not kennel Mates, preferably of the same breed, but not necessarily, and certified running clean by a licenses judge. Please complete the bottom half of the form and attach it to the entry form for the hound's first entry in a trial.

Waiver of Requirement: This requirement will be waived for a hound that has earned a lure coursing title from another recognized organization is such title required competition, and if a waiver for such title has been approved by the Canadian Kennel Club. If your hound qualifies for a waiver, complete the top half of this form and attach it to your entry form.

All hounds must be a minimum of 12 months of age prior to being certified.
All hounds must run a normal course of 600 yards in order to be certified.

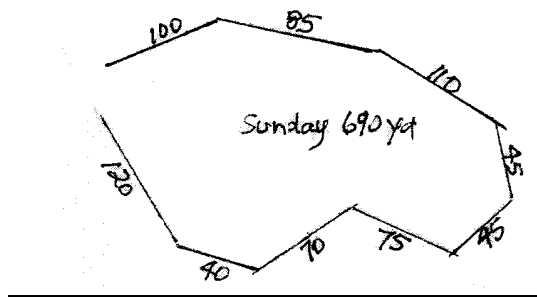
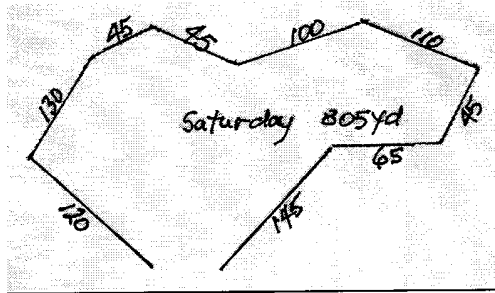

DIRECTIONS TO THE FIELD LOCATION:

Approximate GPS coordinates: N 51 13 37.1 W 114 05 36.6

From the North:

QE Hwy #2 south through Airdrie to Balzac overpass. Exit west (right) on Hwy 566. Go west on Hwy 566 through Balzac to Rge Rd 14. Turn right on Rge Rd 14 and go north to Wet Creek Stable & K9 Centre. Access to the field is just north of the arena. Signs will be posted.

From the South:

QE Hwy #2 through Calgary to Balzac overpass. If you enter Airdrie, you've gone too far. Exit west (left) on Hwy 566 and follow directions from North.

From the West:

Trans Canada Hwy #1 to Hwy #22 north at Cochrane. Follow Hwy #22 through Cochrane to Hwy #567 (Big Hill Sprints Road). Turn right and go east on Big Hill Springes Road (you will cross Hwy #772) to Rge Rd 14. Turn right on Rge Rd 14 and go south to Wet Creek Stable & K9 Centre. Access to the field is just north of the arena. Signs will be posted.

From the East:

Trans Canada Hwy #1 to Hwy #9. Turn right on Hwy #9 and go north to Hwy #566 where you turn left. Go west on Hwy #566 across the QE Hwy #2 through Balzac and follow directions from North.

Camping will be permitted on the grounds, port-a-potty will be available.

Any exhibitor not cleaning up after their dog will be assessed a fine of \$10.00 – strictly enforced! DO NOT STUFF POOP BAGS DOWN GOPHER HOLES!

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be asked to leave the trial site.

Equipment:

Battery-powered drag line lure machine, with white plastic streamers as the lure.

PLEASE COME EARLY AND HELP FILL GOPHER HOLES.

Eligibility to enter these trials

Open to any Afghan, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Pharaoh Hound, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Whippet, Irish Wolfhound.

All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration with the CKC.

Spayed and neutered dogs may compete.

Dogs presently disqualified under CKC, ASFA, or AKC rules are not eligible.

Hounds must prequalify before entering their first trial in Canada. If applicable, please provide proper certification with your entry. See below

First time entered hounds:

Effective July 1998, hounds entering their first trial in Canada must be tested with another dog, not a kennel mate, preferably of the same breed, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. The CKC Hound Certification form (included with this premium list) must be completed and submitted with their entry at the hound's first trial. Hounds with the following are exempt:

Field Championship points:

Points awarded as follows:

1st place - 4x number of dogs competing for a maximum of 40 pts.

2nd place - 3x number competing for maximum of 30 pts.

3rd place - 2x number competing for a maximum of 20 pts.

4th place - 1x number competing for a maximum of 10 pts.

NBQ (Next Best Qualified) - no points awarded.

Event Registration Numbers:

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with a cheque money order or VISA/Mastercard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$55.00 + 5% GST payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for with 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC Event. Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Entry Payment: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars.

***Border crossing – A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada.

Withdrawal of entries:

Anyone wishing to withdraw an entry prior to the close by email MUST follow up the email with a phone call for confirmation of the withdrawal.

Extracts from CKC dog shows rules

Section 7.2 DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered nonpayment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 16 - DISQUALIFICATION

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a CKC event held under these rules cannot again be entered until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action.

All entries must be complete, signed and must be submitted on the current official CKC entry form.

Entries submitted in any other size or format will be rejected. Telephone entries are not accepted and entries received without full entry fees will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayment or duplicate entries. Please type or print legibly in black ink.

WAIVER

I personally assume all responsibility and liability and I further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by an person or persons, including myself, or on account of damage of property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
